IN THE WORKS

COCHRAN/CARTER INTERSECTION - The Engineering Department is reviewing alignment options for the widening of Cochran Road at Carter Street and the addition of left turn lanes in both directions.

VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK - The foundation work for the seating wall, fence columns and gazebo are complete. The site has been rough graded and installation of the sidewalk is underway.

BUILDING CODE AMENDMENTS - Currently under study is an amendment to the Building Code to require that all projects must be constructed in a workmanlike manner. The intent is to go beyond the Ohio Building Code requirement that structures be sound and to insure that they also meet a basic level of aesthetic quality and appearance, such as being level and uniform in materials.

Also under study is an ordinance to establish more stringent fines for commencing construction prior to the issuance of a building permit.

KUDOS - The City of Solon was one of twelve cities in Ohio that received a gold medal from the Ohio Department of Health for being a healthy community. The "Healthy Ohio" program honors institutions that promote health for employees and residents through implementation of health-related policies and by providing healthy community environments.
